COMMANDER WILLIAM J. MARSHALL WAS BORN IN NEW YORK CITY, NEW YORK, NOVEMBER 22, 1947. UPON GRADUATION FROM OLD DOMINION UNIVERSITY IN 1972, HE EARNED HIS COMMISSION THROUGH OFFICER CANDIDATE SCHOOL AT NEWPORT, RHODE ISLAND. HE THEN REPORTED ABOARD USS IWO JIMA (LPH-2), HOMEPORTED IN NORFOLK, VIRGINIA. HE SERVED FROM JUNE 1972 UNTIL FEBRUARY 1975, AS CIC OFFICER, 1ST DIVISION OFFICER AND DAMAGE CONTROL ASSISTANT.

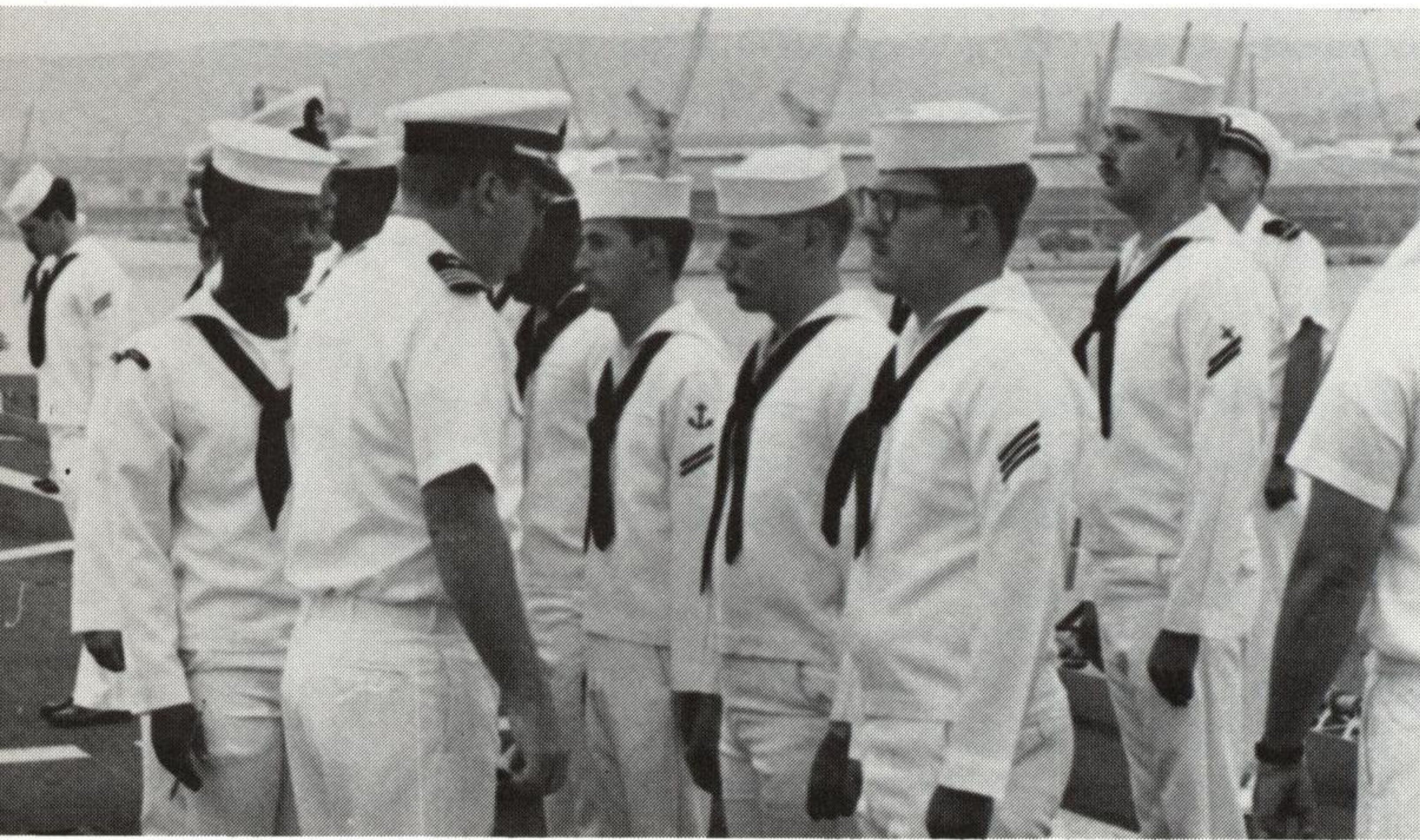
HIS NEXT TOUR OF DUTY WAS ABOARD USS ALBANY (CG-10), SIXTH FLEET FLAG SHIP, HOMEPORTED IN GAETA, ITALY, WHERE HE SERVED AS TARTAR MISSILE BATTERY OFFICER FROM APRIL 1975 TO FEBRUARY 1977. THIS ASSIGNMENT WAS FOLLOWED BY CIC/TAO INSTRUCTOR DUTY FROM APRIL 1977 TO AUGUST 1979, AT FLEET COMBAT TRAINING CENTER ATLANTIC, DAM NECK, VIRGINIA. DURING THIS PERIOD, COMMANDER MARSHALL RECEIVED A MASTERS DEGREE IN ADMINISTRATION FROM GEORGE WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY.

IN SEPTEMBER 1979, HE REPORTED TO THE SURFACE WARFARE OFFICER DEPARTMENT HEAD SCHOOL AT NEWPORT, RHODE ISLAND. THIS WAS FOLLOWED BY A TOUR OF DUTY AS WEAPONS OFFICER ABOARD THE CHARLESTON, SOUTH CAROLINA-BASED USS BLAKELY (FF-1072) FROM JUNE 1980 TO JANUARY 1982.

CDR MARSHALL THEN REPORTED AS CHIEF ENGINEER ABOARD USS SPIEGEL GROVE (LSD-32), FROM MAY 1982 TO OCTOBER 1983. BEFORE REPORTING ONBOARD USS TRENTON IN DECEMBER 1985, COMMANDER MARSHALL SERVED AS MATERIAL OFFICER FOR COMMANDER AMPHIBIOUS SQUADRON TEN FROM NOVEMBER 1983 TO NOVEMBER 1985.

COMMANDER MARSHALL'S AWARDS INCLUDE THE NAVY COMMENDATION MEDAL (THREE AWARDS), HUMANITARIAN SERVICE MEDAL, MERITORIOUS UNIT CITATION, ARMED FORCES EXPEDITIONARY MEDAL, BATTLE "E" AND SEA SERVICE RIBBON.

HE IS MARRIED TO THE FORMER KATHLEEN RAMSEY OF NORFOLK, VIRGINIA. THEY HAVE TWO CHILDREN, BILL JR. AND MARGARET.
