CDR. G. E. MUELLER

Commander George E. Mueller enlisted in the Navy in 1945 and was appointed to the U.S. Naval Academy in 1947. He was commissioned Ensign in 1951 and then served in **USS BLUE (DD-744)** during the Korean Campaign. He received orders to submarine school in 1953.

CDR. Mueller was served in the submarines **USS STICKLEBACK**, **USS BASHAW**, **USS GROWLER**, and **USS GRAYBACK**. He has commanded the submarines **USS BARBERO** and **USS GUDGEON**.

CDR. Mueller has served as Comm. Officer on the Staff of COMSUBRON ONE, and as Asst. Officer in Charge of Guided Missile Unit 55 at Point Magu, Calif. From 1965-7, he served in the Strategic Plans Division of the Office of the CNO and then served as Executive Officer in **USS HERMITAGE (LSD-34)**. CRD. Mueller commanded **USS CASA GRANDE (LSD-13)**.

A graduate of the Naval War College, CDR. Mueller also holds a M.S. degree in International Relations from George Washington University. CDR. Mueller is married to the former Elizabeth Hamilton of Palo Alto, Calif. and has three sons.
